Each scholarship covers tuition fees, accommodation, living expenses and airfares for two academic years in the UK.

每個獎學金包括兩年英國學士課程的 學費、住宿、生活及來回機票費用。



### **Purpose**

The Scholarship aims to provide students, nominated by the Vocational Training Council (VTC), with financial sponsorship to further their studies at universities in the United Kingdom (UK). The awardees have to obtain admission to Year 2 or 3 of a science and technology-related bachelor's degree programme in the UK in September 2025.

# **Eligibility**

An applicant must fulfill the following criteria:

- born in Hong Kong;
- both parents are Hong Kong permanent residents;
- be a final year student in AY2024/25, or a graduate in recent TWO years, of a full-time Higher Diploma (HD) programme in one of the following disciplines: Engineering, Health and Life Sciences or Information Technology; and
- have excellent academic achievements and strong commitment in extra-curricular activities and community services.

### **Awardee Selection**

The Selection Panel will recommend a list of awardees, considering the candidates' academic & non-academic attainments, commitment to study abroad and interview performance. The Alistair Harvey Foundation will then approve the selected awardees.

# Duration and Coverage of the Awards

Normally scholarships for TWO consecutive academic years; i.e. AY2025/26 and AY2026/27 for Cohort 2025/26, with full sponsorship to cover:

- Tuition;
- Term-time accommodation expenses:
- Round trip airfares; and
- Maintenance fees.

Awardees will also be given an option to receive full sponsorship in the first year of study, then tuition sponsorship only for the two subsequent years, should they wish to pursue Master study in the thrid year. If the awardee is unable to successfully complete any year of study, no further subsidies from the Foundation will be provided.

### Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend the First Interview. Recommended candidates will be invited to Final Interview. The performance of the interviews will play an important role during the selection process.

## **Conditions of the Scholarship**

- 1. The award of the Scholarship is conditional upon the awardee being offered a place by the university in the UK, and meeting certain health and immigration as well as admission requirements.
- 2. The bachelor's degree programme to be pursued should be science and technology-related under any one of the following disciplines:
  - Engineering
  - Health and Life Sciences
  - Information Technology
- 3. The awardee is required:
  - o to be proficient in English language and to meet the necessary requirements for university admission, such as a minimum overall score 6.0 on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or satisfying any English requirements specified by university;
  - to pursue study diligently and to conform to all the rules and regulations of the university;
  - not to transfer to another educational institution during the programme of study without the prior approval of the Foundation and VTC;
  - to keep in close contact with VTC and the Foundation and, in particular, to keep all parties informed of all changes including address in the UK even if only temporary, or curtailment, or intended curtailment of studies; and
  - to submit proof of satisfactory academic performance with "Annual Report" to the Foundation via VTC by July of each year.
- 4. The awardee's acceptance of the Scholarship shall constitute an agreement with the Foundation. VTC has no obligation in this regard.
- 5. The awardee accepts that the Scholarship may be terminated at any time if and when the performance as reported by the institution is considered by the Foundation as unsatisfactory, or when he/she for any reason ceases to be a full-time undergraduate/postgraduate.
- Approval from the Foundation and VTC should be sought if the awardee intends to defer/deregister for the programme studying.

# **Application for the Scholarship**

The Foundation has the right to accept/not to accept an application. The decision of the Foundation is final. Completed Application Form must be submitted through Campus Secretariat together with proven documents to the Institutional Advancement Office (IAO) on or before 1 November 2024 (Friday).

## **Application Guide**

- 1. Please complete Part A to E.
- 2. Where appropriate, please put down "NIL" or "NA"; and to ensure that the form is completed with accurate information.
- 3. Your provision of all the personal data requested in this form is obligatory. Your application will not be considered if you fail to provide all required information or it is not clear from your statements that you have fulfilled the criteria for the Scholarship.
- 4. After submission of the application form, you are obligated to notify IAO if there are any subsequent changes to the information provided, including university/programme choices and updates on application status.
- 5. The completed Application Form must be submitted through your Campus Secretariat with the recommendation from the Head of Department that you are studying/have studied, together with a copy of the following documents:

(Note: Do not send any originals of diplomas/certificates or other qualification documents.)

- a. Your VTC Student Card (applicable to final year students only);
- b. Your last VTC academic transcript (applicable to graduates only);
- c. Hong Kong Identity Cards of your parents and you with **live signatures**; and
- d. Other supporting documents: academic reports; and record of extra-curricular activities/community services
- 6. You are advised to make a photocopy of the completed application form for your own reference.
